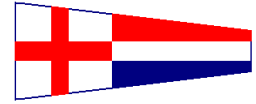

### INFORMATION FOR THOSE COMING TO THE PICNIC

#### PICNICKING, EATING & SIPPING

This is a BYO (Bring Your Own) picnic, so what you bring and where and how you eat it are up to you. You may be as elaborate or as rustic as you chose—but please remember: if you want tables and chairs or even a rug to sit on, you will need to BYO. However—please do NOT bring your own barbecue outfit, primus and kettle or anything else that requires a naked flame. We may not light fires, of any sort, within the Castle grounds

#### THE BBQ

We have borrowed and shall use the big (approximately 2ft wide by 8ft long) BBQ trough owned by the Friends of Hurst Castle (of which group the CSO and Susan are members) and this will be lit and run by Jason Crane. Jason's primary task is to watch over the fire and make sure it stays inside the BBQ trough and to co-ordinate use of the range. You may cook your own food on the BBQ (it is big enough for several people to cook on it at once) or Jason will cook your food for you. Don't forget to bring something off which to eat your food (a plate, for example) and something with which to eat it. All that will be provided is the BBQ fire itself.

#### DRINKS

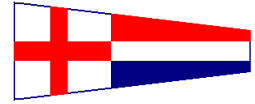
There is no drinking water supply in our area of the Castle, so in addition to any wines or soft drinks you are planning to bring, you should bring your own bottled water.

#### GAMES

Please bring any family games you want to play during the Picnic – a few, like Boules, will be brought by the organisers. There is plenty of space available both in the Royal Thames enclave inside the Castle walls and outside. However, do remember that swimming around Hurst Spit can be dangerous, so if any family members are going in the water, choose your spot with care.

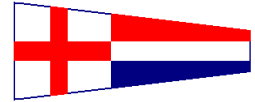
**INFORMATION FOR THOSE COMING TO THE PICNIC**

**WET & STORMY WEATHER**

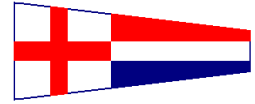


**Programme of Events**
